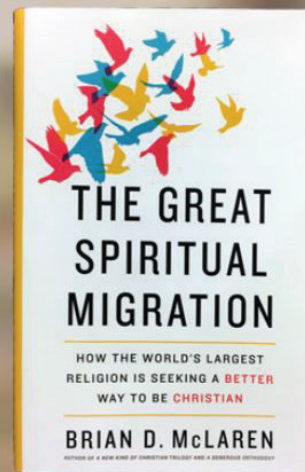


The Great Spiritual Migration

In this retreat, Brian McLaren will share his belief that—
notwithstanding the dire headlines about the demise of faith and drop in church attendance—Christian faith is not dying. Rather, it is embarking on a once-in-an-era spiritual shift. Themes covered include three key migrations reshaping the practice of faith:

- Spiritually, focusing less on a system of beliefs and more on a way of life rooted in love;
- Theologically, rejecting the image of God as a violent Supreme Being and embracing instead the renewing Spirit at work in our world;
- Missionally, identifying less with organized religion and more with an organizing religion of Jesus followers dedicated to healing the planet, building peace and working for the common good of all.

Brian D. McLaren is a Christian thinker, global activist, and author of more than a dozen books. A former college English teacher and pastor, he is an Auburn Senior Fellow and a leader in Convergence, a mobilizing collective rooted in a just and generous Christian spirituality.
